CHARTER STANDARD COMMUNITY CLUB CLUB RULES



This Club expects you—regardless of whether you are one of its players, managers, trainers, parent or guardian of one or more of its players or are simply a spectator;

- To behave well at matches and during training sessions.

That means we would like you to, Adhere to and promote fair play; & respect others, behaving towards them in the way that you would like them to behave towards you;

- Create a supportive environment for the football to be played in, whereby positive aspects of play are praised and mistakes by players, match officials or others are not ridiculed;
- Appreciate the importance of effort, of performance and of striving to win, rather than of winning itself;
- Be a role model for others involved in football; and generally be a credit to your Club.
- Any disciplinary fine imposed by the League against any football club member is to be paid by the football club member involved.
- All annual registration fees must be paid prior to the start of the season.

We think this is so important that when completing and signing Players Application Form, players and their parents/guardians agree to become members of our club and agree to abide by and observe the various codes of conduct and these Rules.

- Players Code of Conduct;
- Coaches & managers Code of Conduct;
- Parents spectators code of conduct;

Disciplinary action will be taken by the Management Committee against any club member not abiding by the clubs rules & code of conduct, which could lead to;

1. A Warning as to future conduct and a match ban
2. Suspension from membership and a match ban
3. Removal from our club membership

Disciplinary Code of Conduct

This Code applies to every match in which you represent this Club as a player, manager/asst parent /supporter whether it be league, cup 5 a-side or friendly. For the purpose of this Code, 'a match' means the period commencing 30 minutes before kick-off and ending 30 minutes after the final whistle.

The three rules of the Code are as follows:

1. Any player using language, or making a gesture, which is or may be considered to be threatening, abusive, insulting or offensive, may be withdrawn from the field of play by his manager if not done so by the ref and will receive a two match ban.
2. Any player seen to punch, kick or in any way strike another person which is seen to be deliberate will result in that person being withdrawn from the field of play by his manager if not done so by the ref and will receive a two match ban.
3. If a parent/guardian, relative or friend of a player breaches any of the above rules as a spectator, they will be asked to leave the grounds or area.

Any breaches of the above Code may result in that player being suspended from the Club or even expelled from the Club for life.

Managers who do not enforce this Code have been informed that they may, at the discretion of the Club Management Committee, have their team withdrawn from all competitions and disbanded.

Although the Rules are quite lengthy, the message is a simple one:

We want everyone involved in this Club to enjoy their football without spoiling others enjoyment of it.

Please help us to make that possible.

Players should note that failure to comply with this Code of Conduct could result in them being suspended from team selection or in extreme cases being asked to leave the club.
